**Chairman's Pen**

*My dear fellow exporters,*

*The new Foreign Trade Policy 2009-14 was announced by the Hon'ble Union Commerce & Industry Minister, Shri Anand Sharma on August 27, 2009 in New Delhi. You are aware that a large number of measures that were suggested by EEPC INDIA to the various Ministries and senior Government Officials have been incorporated both in the Union Budget and the new Foreign Trade Policy. Despite the efforts, there are still many other areas where further reforms and procedural improvements are required. Council has prepared some suggestions that is being forwarded to the Government for the benefit of its consideration.*

*Some of the measures that are being taken with the Government include, among others, are reversal of 15% value addition on Advance Authorization Scheme. Engineering sector is the most employment intensive segment of India's organized industry. Council suggests that to include engineering as "Priority Sector" under Chapter 1B of the Foreign Trade Policy so that certain Special Focus Initiative can be provided to the engineering sector. With regard to Directorate of Trade Remedy measures, it is felt that the guidelines of the Directorate should be made user friendly and EPCs like EEPC India should be used as a platform to disseminate information with respect to such trade remedy instruments given that engineering industry is one of the major sectors that suffers from countervailing measures imposed by trade partners. We have suggested including some more items in the FPS/Market linked Focus Product Scheme. Also, while major Latin American countries have been included in the FMS, however Brazil has not been included. EEPC India suggests to include Brazil in the FMS.*

### About UAE

The United Arab Emirates (UAE) comprises seven states: Abu Dhabi (the capital city), Dubai, Sharjah, Ajman, Umm Al Quwain, Ras Al Khaimah and Fujairah. The total area of the country is about 83,600 square kilometres, much of it in Abu Dhabi emirate. Dubai, with an area of 3,885 square kilometres, is the second largest emirate. Dubai is situated on the banks of the Dubai Creek (a natural inlet from the Gulf) which divides the city into the Deira district to its north, and Bur Dubai on its south, the city ranks as the UAE's most important port and commercial centre. The UAE has 700 kilometres of coastline, of which 100 kilometres are on the Gulf of Oman. Along the Arabian Gulf coast there are offshore islands, coral reefs and sabkha, or salt marshes. Stretches of gravel plain and sandy desert characterize the inland region. To the east, a range of mountains lies close to the Gulf of Oman and forms a backbone through the Mussandam Peninsula. The western interior of the country, most of it in Abu Dhabi, consists mainly of desert interspersed with oases.

### The Opportunity – UAE

The UAE, rich in oil and natural gas, has become highly prosperous after gaining foreign direct investment funding in the 1970s. The country has a relatively high Human Development Index for the Asian continent, ranking 39th globally, and had a GDP purchasing power parity of \$ 293.5 billion in 2009 according to the IMF.

The Gulf Countries have been trade partners of India for centuries. The discovery of Oil opened a new era of Industrialization of this region. The Gulf markets are growing markets for Indian engineering goods. Export of engineering items to this region during the period April 2007- February 2008 stood at US\$ 6078 million compared with US\$ 5382 million during the same period of the previous year, registering an overall growth of 12.93 per cent.

### **About Indonesia**

Indonesia has emerged as one of the most potential countries in the South East Asian Region immediately after Singapore. India's engineering exports achieved a growth of 2.09% during 2008-09 over the previous year, which has lot of scope for growth. The recent trend in the export growth of engineering products and services to Indonesia could be a focal point to capitalize on the opportunities existing over there.

Indonesia boasts one of South East Asia's most vibrant economies, the fruit of decades of industrial growth and political stability.

### **Indonesia's Business Scenario**

Indonesia has the largest economy in South East Asia, and is one of the emerging market economies of the world. It has a market-based economy in which the government plays a significant role by owning more than 164 state-owned enterprises. As per "The Economist" estimated GDP for 2008 was US\$ 510.8 billion. The economy's performance in the first quarter of 2009, when real GDP grew by 4.4% year on year, was surprisingly strong, mainly owing to the resilience of private consumption. In 2008 merchandise exports (fob) rose by 18% to US\$ 139 billion and imports (fob) expanded by 36.6% to US\$ 116 billion. Major imports are Machinery and Electrical Equipment (26% of total import) and Base Metals (11.9% of total import). Industrial sector has more than 40% contribution in GDP with major industries including petroleum and natural gas, textiles, apparel, and mining. Indonesia's machine tool & metalworking industries are creating higher demand for machines, technology and solutions.



Indonesia is also a part of the ASEAN trade block. The bilateral agreement between India and the ASEAN countries will provide newer opportunities to the Indian business community.

Under AFTA's Common Effective Preferential Tariffs (CEPT), ASEAN member countries have agreed to progressively reduce import duties, ranging from zero to 5%, on all products. As an original member, Indonesia fully implements CEPT.
