*I met the DGFT Shri R. S. Gujral on July 29, 2009 and raised various issues pertaining to engineering exports. Among the major suggestions I made was the inclusion of a Technology Upgradation Fund Scheme for the engineering sector, a Joint Standing Committee on Procedures which will have the Joint Chairmanship of Chairman CBEC and DGFT so that policy conflicts can be resolved; extension of DEPB rate till GST comes into effect; extension of Interest Subvention to the engineering sector; increase in line of credit by the Exim Bank to developing countries; preparing a plan of action for vendor development in the country etc.*

*I am also glad to inform you that the Board of Trade have been re-constituted and the first meeting will be held on August 10, 2009 in New Delhi. This Board of Trade will be chaired by Hon'ble Commerce & Industry Minister Shri Anand Sharma, and the Council will be making detailed suggestion to the Hon'ble Commerce Minister.*

**About UAE**

The United Arab Emirates (UAE) comprises seven states: Abu Dhabi (the capital city), Dubai, Sharjah, Ajman, Umm Al Quwain, Ras Al Khaimah and Fujairah. The total area of the country is about 83,600 square kilometres, much of it in Abu Dhabi emirate. Dubai, with an area of 3,885 square kilometres, is the second largest emirate. Dubai is situated on the banks of the Dubai Creek (a natural inlet from the Gulf) which divides the city into the Deira district to its north, and Bur Dubai on its south, the city ranks as the UAE's most important port and commercial centre. The UAE has 700 kilometres of coastline, of which 100 kilometres are on the Gulf of Oman. Along the Arabian Gulf coast there are offshore islands, coral reefs and sabkha, or salt marshes. Stretches of gravel plain and sandy desert characterize the inland region. To the east, a range of mountains lies close to the Gulf of Oman and forms a backbone through the Mussandam Peninsula. The western interior of the country, most of it in Abu Dhabi, consists mainly of desert interspersed with oases.

**The Opportunity – UAE**

The UAE, rich in oil and natural gas, has become highly prosperous after gaining foreign direct investment funding in the 1970s. The country has a relatively high Human Development Index for the Asian continent, ranking 39th globally, and had a GDP purchasing power parity of \$ 293.5 billion in 2009 according to the IMF.

The Gulf Countries have been trade partners of India for centuries. The discovery of Oil opened a new era of Industrialization of this region.
