Ukraine gained its independence after the collapse of the Soviet Union in 1991. Promises of more market openness and economic reform after Ukraine's 2004 "Orange Revolution" have fallen short, and infighting between President Victor Yushchenko and Prime Minister Victor Yanukovich has generated instability. Prominent sectors of the economy include services, mining, metals, and manufacturing. The agricultural sector is strong but overregulated through quotas and tariffs on grain exports. Ukraine has benefited heavily from recent increases in the prices of metals. Despite lucrative opportunities for foreign direct investment, economic progress in the near term may be slowed by persistent corruption, steadily increasing gas prices, deteriorating infrastructure, and political uncertainty.

Trade Policy

Ukraine's weighted average tariff rate was 3.9 percent in 2002. Some export restrictions, service market access barriers, import taxes and fees, import licensing requirements, restrictive sanitary and phytosanitary regulations, complex standards and certification regulations, non-transparent government procurement, and weak enforcement of intellectual property rights add to the cost of trade. An additional 10 percentage points is deducted from Ukraine's trade freedom score to account for non-tariff barriers.

Government Intervention

Total government expenditures, including consumption and transfer payments, are high. In the most recent year, government spending equaled 43.6 percent of GDP. The government has privatized over 80 percent of its public enterprises, but the economy is still shackled by government intervention in the private sector.

Foreign Investment

The laws provide equal treatment with some restrictions in publishing, broadcasting, energy, and insurance. Foreign investment in weapons manufacturing and alcoholic spirits is prohibited. Complex regulations and corruption are major deterrents. Contracts are not always honored by the legal system. The current government is unwilling to continue its predecessor's re-examination of old, allegedly tainted privatization deals. Resident and non-resident foreign exchange accounts are subject to restrictions and government approval in some cases. Payments and transfers are subject to various requirements and quantitative limits. Some capital transactions are subject to controls and licenses.

Import regulations and Customs Duties

Regulations

The only important barrier to trade and investment in Ukraine is the country's difficulty in transiting from a planned economy to a market economy. Following economic reforms, the country experienced a relative success concerning export and investment but all this requires perspectives and a long-term strategy. There are real structural barriers putting a break on trade and investment in Ukraine : corruption, lack of protection in terms of intellectual or industrial property, lack of foreign exchange, an ill defined or too bureaucratic hierarchy, an inefficient and little developed banking system, law, licenses and tariffs changes. Investment is precisely curbed by the absence of private property and a coherent privatisation programme, non convertibility of the country's currency and lack of financial liquidity, change of legislation relating to investment, lack of quality, lack of competitive prices for hiring or purchasing offices of representatives, poor infrastructures, political instability.

Customs Duties

The import duties to be paid by a foreign importer in Ukraine vary according to the type of product: alcohol, tobacco, motor cars, tyres, jewellery and other luxury products. The payment of these duties must be effected in the country's currency. Excise duties are also paid in the local currency and are calculated as follows: for non luxury products, a percentage is applied and for luxury products the excise duty is not calculated on the customs declared value but according to volume, number of units or weight of the import.

Visa Information

No visas are required for citizens of Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Georgia, Hungary, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, Poland, Romania, Russia, Uzbekistan.

Nationals of Andorra, Belgium, Canada, Cyprus, Czech, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Holy See Hungary, Iceland, Ireland, Italy, Japan, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Monaco, Netherlands, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland, UK, USA may stay in Ukraine up to 90 days without a visa.

Everyone else will need a visa, an invitation or tourist voucher may be required.

Transportation

Road

The road network is in poor condition. Drive carefully, avoid driving at night outside the cities, watch the behaviour of local people, who often do not respect the highway code and the general traffic rules. Also watch the pedestrians. Having an insurance for your vehicle is compulsory.

Rail

It is satisfactory on the whole, but journeys are slow (it takes one night to join the main cities in the province from Kiev). It is often difficult to get a return ticket in the station of departure.

Air

The domestic fleet is composed of old planes. For international flights, it is advised to travel with Occidental airline companies or on "Air Ukraine International" which jets meet the international safety standards.

Transportation of goods

By Road

The position of Ukraine is strategic: it is situated between Europe and Russia and constitutes a buoyant sector for the country. The road network of this country gathers 170,000 km of national highways and 2,60,000 km of local network. The road network represents nearly two thirds of the national transport system but goods transport by road tends to diminish.

By Rail

Concerning the railway network, half of the 227,000 km of railway lines are electrified. The means of air transport is not very safe. It is better to use trains (certainly slow and not comfortable) or hire a vehicle with a chauffeur.

By Sea

Maritime transport is carried on through nearly 30 ports. The river transport extends over 5,000 km of which the Dniestr river holds less than half the navigable surface.

Doing Business in Ukraine

Local business incentives

Registration and licensing procedures

A new business, with foreign participation, has to be registered with the administration of the district where it will be set up. Besides documents concerning the company setting up, for registration purposes, the foreign partner must provide a whole list of documents and notably a K-bis certificate, a Ukrainian bank's certificate guaranteeing that the company can honour its commitments. These documents must be authenticated by a French notary, legalized by the French Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Consulate of Ukraine in France and translated into Ukrainian.

The legal registration delay is currently 5 working days after the sending in of the whole file. The foreign investment must be registered within the 3 working days of the contribution deposit.

Foreign exchange control

The first anti-crisis measures have been, above all, focused on exchange control: suspension of pre-payments; obligation to use letters of credit for payments to non-residents; compulsory conversion of 50% of export receipts; suspension of foreign currencies interbank transactions; suspension of open positions for banks.

Regulations concerning equity investment

The legislation provides the possibility to create a Ukrainian company with foreign investments in a Private Limited Company, in a joint-stock company, or in a 100% subsidiary form, and regulates their constitution and running. Partial take-over of an existing company, notably within an undergoing privatisation programme, is subject to the same legal procedures but requires approval from the State Assets Funds.
