Notification No. 23 (RE-2008)/2004-2009

Dated 8th July, 2008

S.O. (E) In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 5 of the Foreign Trade (Development & Regulation) Act, 1992 (No. 22 of 1992) read with Para 1.3 and Para 2.1 of the Foreign Trade Policy, 2004-09, the Central Government hereby makes the following amendments in Chapter 12 of Schedule-2 of the ITC (HS) Classifications of Export and Import items, 2004-09, as amended from time to time :

“Export Licensing Note 2

- (i) However, in respect of CITES species, a CITES permit of export shall be required
- (ii) Exports allowed only through the Ports of Mumbai, Nhava Sheva, Kolkata, Cochin, Delhi, Chennai, Tuticorin, Amritsar, Calicut, Thiruvananthapuram, Kandla and Mundra
- (iii) Except for the documents prescribed above, no additional information/NOC/documents shall be required to be furnished by the Exporter to any authority of State or Central Government”
