According to Article 4.1 (iii) of the Articles of Association of the Council, Members shall at the time of applying for membership, indicate giving reasons therefore, the Panel in which he wishes to be primarily registered and the other panel or panels with which he also wishes to be associated. The admission of an Associate Member as primary member of a Panel shall be decided by the Committee of Administration or any other Committee or Sub-Committee to which powers therefore are delegated by the Working Committee. In case, a member decides to be also associated with other Panel/ panels such member will pay such additional fees per annum for each additional Panel, as may be determined by the Working Committee, from time to time.

### **CONSTITUTION/RECONSTITUTION OF PANELS**

According to Article 16(a) of the Articles of Association of the Council, the Working Committee may constitute/reconstitute panels, from time to time, and such constitution/reconstitution shall be based on the export performance in groups of engineering products and also on such well defined criteria, as may be laid down, for the purpose by the Working Committee. Panel covering a commodity group must ordinarily account for export performance of one percent of total export performance, in engineering products in the preceding year. The Council may, with the approval of Government, make relaxation in this regard, and reconstitute panels in fields such as consultancy services and for commodities in which exports may have immediate potential for growth although at the time of constitution of the panel the exports may be below the said one percent of total export of engineering goods in the previous year.

### **CHANGES OF MEMBERSHIP OF PANELS**

According to Article 4.1 (iv) of the Articles of Association of the Council Once members are enrolled under various Panels, changing to other Panels will not be permitted except after an interval of two years. Applications for such changes shall be made to the Council, subject to fulfillment of following criteria, giving reasons therefore, within two months of the beginning of the year. The Working Committee or any other Committee or Sub-Committee to which power therefore are delegated by Working Committee shall decide such requests for changes of membership of Panels. However, eligibility for classification into another Panel will be decided based on following criteria in force.

#### **In Case of Manufacturer - Exporter :**

They should be registered as a MSME/ DGTD/ SIA unit for the manufacture of the item concerned. The product should be their best or the second best item of production/export during current plus three previous years.

#### **In Case of Merchant Exporter categorised as Export House/Star Export House/ Trading House / Star Trading House and Premier Trading House :**

The product representing a Panel should be the best or the second best item of their export during current plus previous three years (taken together).

For ascertaining primary interest of the firms/companies, Manufacturer-Exporters must furnish to the Council a certificate from the Chartered Accountant certifying their itemwise production in terms of value for the preceding year. Similarly, Merchant Exporter categorized as Export House / Star Export House / Trading House / Star Trading House and Premier Trading House, must submit a statement of their itemwise export performance during current plus previous three years in terms of value certified by the Chartered Accountant.

Merchant-Exporters having no export should send a statement of their itemwise domestic turnover of engineering goods in terms of value during current plus previous three years certified by a Chartered Accountant. If there is neither domestic turnover nor export turnover they may be given primary registration in one Panel of their choice, Export Houses / Star Export Houses / Trading Houses / Star Trading Houses / Premier Trading Houses shall send a copy of their valid recognition certificate as such granted to them by the Office of DGFT, New Delhi.

#### **Additional Panel :**

Where a firm/company wants to be primarily registered in one Panel and associated with other Panel/Panels as well, such firm/company should pay Rs. 1,000/-per annum for each additional panel.

  - (i) MSME                      Rs. 30 Lakhs
  - (ii) Others                      Rs. 50 Lakhs
- (c) On becoming eligible to become an ordinary member, it is incumbent upon the Associate member to apply to the Committee of Administration in the prescribed format expressing his willingness to become an Ordinary member.

Members are requested to kindly let us know their option for conversion of category of membership from Associate to Ordinary within **29<sup>th</sup> March, 2013** alongwith a copy of CA certificates certifying export performance of the members during the 3 financial years immediately preceding as well as a copy of valid MSME certificate (in case of MSME applicant member) for consideration of Committee on Membership and Panel Classification.
