## Payment & Cancellation

Full payment should be made along with **Registration Form**, duly filled in latest by **31st May, 2012**. The payment should be made by way of **Demand Draft** drawn in favour of "EEPC India" or Swift Transfer as indicated above.

## Selection Criteria

EEPC India will recommend for issuance of visas for a maximum number of two participants for each 8.1 sqm booth.
