My dear fellow exporters,



EEPC Invites Participation for India Pavilion at 15th Vietnam International Industrial Fair 2006, Hanoi (October 17 - 21, 2006)

EEPC is taking part in the **15th Vietnam International Industrial Fair 2006**, to be held in Hanoi during October 17 to 21, 2006.

FOCUS ASEAN + 2 Approach

Subsequent to the FOCUS ASEAN + 2 programme announced by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India as a part of the Look East Policy, and keeping in view the potential of this region to be a major trading partner of India, the Council is undertaking various promotional activities in this region. After a successful Indiatech at Jakarta in March 2005, the Council has taken part in major trade shows in Singapore. Participation in VIIF 2006 is a part of the Council's strategy to promote exports of engineering goods and services in Vietnam.

Economy and Trade of Vietnam

Vietnam's economic growth rate has been among the highest in the world in recent years, expanding annually at 7-8 per cent, while industrial production has been growing at around 14-15 per cent a year. Vietnam aspires to accede to the World Trade Organization (WTO) very soon.

Indo-Vietnam Bilateral Trade

Vietnam is emerging as an important trading partner of India. India's total exports to Vietnam in 2005-06 were worth US\$ 687.11 million, of which exports of engineering goods were at a level of US\$ 127.22 million, indicating a share of 18.5%.

India's total imports from Vietnam in 2005-06 were US\$ 130.45 million, of which US\$ 8.52 million were engineering items.

Primary & semi-finished iron & steel, non-ferrous metals, machinery & instruments, manufactures of metals and aluminium other than products (in order of importance) formed 90% of total exports of engineering goods from India to Vietnam in 2005-06.

India's share in total imports of engineering goods by Vietnam was a little over 1% in 2004.

About VIIF 2006

The Trade Event is being organised by Vietnam Exhibition Fair Centre (VEFAC). The VIIF 2005 attracted more than 30,000 visitors.

The Fair covers a wide spectrum of products, including machinery and equipment in manufacturing, mining, energy, shipbuilding, construction, transportation, processing industries, machine tools, machinery and equipment in plastic, packaging and printing etc.

Focus Products

The following engineering goods have been identified as thrust products for Vietnam :

- Primary iron and steel products
- Pollution control equipments
- Oil and gas machinery and services

INDIA ENGINEERING CENTER (IEC) at Johannesburg, South Africa

Strategically located on the major world trade routes, South Africa has always been a business attraction for countries in the world over. A highly advanced infrastructure has virtually made South Africa the gateway to the entire sub-Saharan Africa. It is often compared to the Europe for its economic activities. Business opportunities between India and South Africa are immense and over the last few years, there has been enormous leap in the bilateral trade.

- Showroom Facility for Display of Products
- Warehousing Facility for Storing the Goods
- Distribution Center
- Marketing Support – Participation in Trade fairs and Advertisements.

Showroom Facility

Showroom of IEC will be an exhibition of goods of participating companies all the year round. This will facilitate the Indian companies to invite their buyers in and around South Africa to the Showroom to look and satisfy themselves on the various aspects connected with quality and specifications of the goods. The Showroom is located at the premier location in Johannesburg with the space of 500 sq. mtrs. The participating company will be provided one standard display window containing the following :

- Area of 1 mtr. x 1 mtr.
- Fascia of the company
- One podium for display of products
- One catalogue holder (A4 size)

Depending on the product, instead of podium, pegboard or other type of platform will be made available. However, at the time of registration, participants will have to declare a list of products to be displayed in the window. Changes of product in the window is permissible within this declared list. 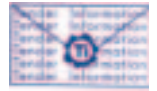

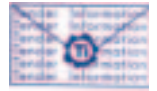

The trend of growth in exports of engineering goods and services over the last three years indicates a steady growth of above 20%. In terms of regional groupings, the most important three markets - NAFTA, EU and ASEAN accounted for more than 47% of the Indian engineering exports. The most important individual market remains the United States, which accounts for more than 14% of the total exports of engineering products and services from India. The European Union in particular the UK, Germany, France, Belgium and Italy are the most important contributors to the engineering exports basket of India. It is notable that South Africa and Nigeria have emerged as top destinations in the African markets. Certain important countries of Indian exports that are primarily trading centres for further distribution include the UAE and Singapore.

Indian exports have shown a higher year - to - year increase in terms of global market share of engineering exports, however, this remains a low at about 0.47%. In order to foster the engineering exports growth, the Council continues its endeavour to double exports of engineering items from India in next 5 years and to take India’s share in the world engineering close to 1%.

Transferable DFIA – Endorsement of the names of supporting manufacturers – Clarification regarding

Representations have been received from exporting community pointing out that some Regional Authorities are insisting for submission of SSI/Central Excise Registration Certificates of supporting manufacturers /jobbers at the time of redemption/issue of EODC in respect of DFIA's, even in cases where the export obligation has already been fulfilled. Attention is invited to

provision contained in Paragraph 4.16 of the Handbook of Procedures, Vol. I which lays down the procedure for availing the facility of supporting manufacturers/jobbers in case of DFIA/ Advance Authorisation holders. This procedure is mandatory in case of users of Actual User DFIA/Advance Authorisation for imports. However, in cases where the exporter seeks redemption and transferability of DFIA on completion of stipulated E.O. (post export DFIA), documentary evidences such as SSI/Central Excise Registration of supporting manufacturer/jobber may not be insisted upon.

Reproduced below the relevant portion of Letter No. Tfc/GZZY 431/JOCC Meeting dated 17th August, 2006 issued by Traffic Department, Kolkata Port Trust for the information of our member-exporters.

The request of CCHAA for allowing cheque facility to deposit account holders on all working days for payment of port charges at the Collection Office has since been considered. The matter has been agreed upon by FA & CAO, KoPT subject to the following conditions –

(1) In the event of cheque(s) issued by the deposit account holder is dishonoured for payment by any bank upon its presentation, Kolkata Port Trust shall

- (i) charge an amount of Rs. 200/- or such amount as may be fixed by the Port Trust from time to time, for every dishonoured cheque.
- (ii) charge penal interest for delayed payment as per provision of the Scale of Rates for the number of days starting from the date when the dishonoured cheque was initially deposited at the Collection Office counters till the date such amount is paid to Kolkata Port Trust in settlement of such amount of dishonoured cheque.

AND

(iii) shall have absolute right to restrict/suspend operations of the deposit account holder in the Port in such manner as may be deemed fit by the Port Trust Authorities at the deposit account holders' cost and expenses. For such action on the part of Kolkata Port Trust against the deposit account holders they should undertake to indemnify Kolkata Port Trust against all claims, legal proceedings, costs and expenses arising, if any, out of such action and shall not hold Kolkata Port Trust responsible for any claim whatsoever.

(2) For availing the aforesaid cheque facility, deposit account holders shall have to give an undertaking as per the enclosed proforma.
