Chairman's Pen



My dear fellow exporters,

Friends, we should be happy about the fact that the Government is seriously considering exports as a major employment generation activity and engineering has been the main booster for employment generation. There has been an overall 50% employment growth in the export segment in 2005-06 and employment in export oriented engineering units grew by 92% in the same period and engineering units having turnover of less than Rs. 10 crore have generated maximum employment.

According to Shri Kamal Nath, Hon'ble Minister of Commerce & Industry, India's 60% population in the age group of 18-25 can be a strength for India and the Government would prefer employment generating exports. A 20% growth in exports in 2004-05 has created 1.4 million additional jobs and by 2010 total incremental employment would be 21 million.

He has also said that manufacturing needs to be taken up to 24-25% of the GDP against the current 17% as this is the main employment generating area. He has also assured engineering exporters of a level playing field.

Council's Eastern Region is conducting a series of SME Export Awareness Workshops to provide appropriate Trade and Finance Solutions. The first such workshop was conducted at Durgapur in association with Asansol Durgapur Development Authority where small and medium exporters were apprised about the benefits of exports, the government support policies for exports, the insurance and ways & means of covering risks in exports and financing solutions, the lifeline of exporters and SMEs.

EEPC plans to take the programme to other important cities in the Eastern Region at Bhubaneshwar, Jamshedpur, Ranchi, Rourkela, Patna and Guwahati.

EEPC Invites Participation for India Pavilion at 15th Vietnam International Industrial Fair 2006, Hanoi

(October 17 - 21, 2006)

EEPC is taking part in the **15th Vietnam** International Industrial Fair **2006**, to be held in Hanoi during October 17 to 21, 2006.

FOCUS ASEAN + 2 Approach

Subsequent to the FOCUS ASEAN + 2 programme announced by the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India as a part of the Look East Policy, and keeping in view the potential of this region to be a major trading partner of India, the Council is undertaking various promotional activities in this region. After a successful Indiatech at Jakarta in March 2005, the Council has taken part in major trade shows in Singapore. Participation in VIIF 2006 is a part of the Council's strategy to promote exports of engineering goods and services in Vietnam.

Economy and Trade of Vietnam

Vietnam's economic growth rate has been among the highest in the world in recent years, expanding annually at 7-8 per cent, while industrial production has been growing at around 14-15 per cent a year. Vietnam aspires to accede to the World Trade Organization (WTO) very soon.

Indo-Vietnam Bilateral Trade

Vietnam is emerging as an important trading partner of India. India's total exports to Vietnam in 2005-06 were worth US\$ 687.11 million, of which exports of engineering goods were at a level of US\$ 127.22 million, indicating a share of 18.5%.

India's total imports from Vietnam in 2005-06 were US\$ 130.45 million, of which US\$ 8.52 million were engineering items.

Primary & semi-finished iron & steel, non-ferrous metals, machinery & instruments, manufactures of metals and aluminium other than products (in order of importance) formed 90% of total exports of engineering goods from India to Vietnam in 2005-06.

India's share in total imports of engineering goods by Vietnam was a little over 1% in 2004.

About VIIF 2006

The Trade Event is being organised by Vietnam Exhibition Fair Centre (VEFAC). The VIIF 2005 attracted more than 30,000 visitors.

The Fair covers a wide spectrum of products, including machinery and equipment in manufacturing, mining, energy, shipbuilding, construction, transportation, processing industries, machine tools, machinery and equipment in plastic, packaging and printing etc.

The trend of growth in exports of engineering goods and services over the last three years indicates a steady growth of above 20%. In terms of regional groupings, the most important three markets - NAFTA, EU and ASEAN accounted for more than 47% of the Indian engineering exports. The most important individual market remains the United States, which accounts for more than 14% of the total exports of engineering products and services from India. The European Union in particular the UK, Germany, France, Belgium and Italy are the most important contributors to the engineering exports basket of India. It is notable that South Africa and Nigeria have emerged as top destinations in the African markets. Certain important countries of Indian exports that are primarily trading centres for further distribution include the UAE and Singapore.

Indian exports have shown a higher year - to - year increase in terms of global market share of engineering exports, however, this remains a low at about 0.47%. Re-export of goods imported under Served from India Scheme (SFIS) and Vishesh Krishi and Gram Udyog Yojana (VKGUY) found defective or unfit for use – reg.

In terms of Para 3.18.2 and Para 3.19.9 of the Handbook of Procedures, Vol. I of Foreign Trade Policy, goods imported under Served from India Scheme (SFIS) and Visesh Krishi and Gram Udyog Yojana (VKGUY), which are found defective or unfit for use, may be re-exported as per guidelines issued by the Department of Revenue. In such cases 98% of the credit amount debited against the SFIS/VKGUY scrip shall be generated in the form of a Certificate.

- 2. The matter has been examined further by the Ministry and it has been decided that in cases where the goods imported under SFIS/VKGUY are found defective or unfit for use, the same may be permitted to be re-exported by the Commissioner of Customs subject to the following conditions:
 - (i) Re-export of goods takes place from the same port from where the goods were imported;
- (ii) The goods are re-exported within 6 months from the date of import;
- (iii) The Deputy Commissioner/Assistant Commissioner of Customs, as the case may be, is satisfied about the identity of the goods; and
- (iv) The goods are not put into use after import.
- 3. In such cases, on re-export of goods, 98% of the credit amount debited in the SFIS/VKGUY scrip shall be generated by the concerned Custom House in the form of a Certificate. The said Certificate shall also contain details of the original SFIS/VKGUY scrip and the value, quantity and description of the goods exported.
- 4. Based on the aforesaid Certificate issued by Customs, the concerned Regional Authority shall issue fresh SFIS/VKGUY scrip for 98% of the credit amount for the same port of registration and the validity of the SFIS/VKGUY scrip so issued shall be for a period equivalent to the balance period available in the earlier SFIS/VKGUY scrip on the date of import of such defective/unfit for use goods.
- 5. A suitable Public Notice and Standing Order may be issued for the guidance of the trade and staff. Difficulties faced, if any in implementation of the Circular may be brought to the notice of the Board at an early date.
