Commencement of investigations on alleged dumping in exports to the Argentine Republic of helicoidal drills

Resolution SICyPyME No. 26/2006 dated February 2, 2006 published at the Official Bulletin on February 6, 2006, determines the continuation of the investigation on alleged dumping in exports to the Argentine Republic of helicoidal drills with cylindrical stem according to norm DIN 338NR. IRAM 5072 of super fast steel type AISI M2, M7 of similar chemical composition, in all its forms of presentation without applying provisory anti-dumping measures. Also, investigations on export of helicoidal drills with normal Morse conic stem, according to DIN 345, IRAM 5076, in super fast steel, type AISI M2, M7 of similar chemical composition, originating from the Republic of India have been closed.
