

All India Drawback Clearance Month extended and Special Drawback Counters are constituted to clear Pending Drawback Claims

Central Board of Excise and Customs has extended the duration of the Drawback Counters for liquidating the pending Drawback Claims up to **30th September, 2005**. Relevant portion of the letter (DO FNO:609/154/2002-DBK dated 18 August, 2005) of Shri P. K. Mohanty, Joint Secretary (Drawback) to Chief Commissioner is appended below :

“The Delhi Exporters Association has suggested to the Board to extend the Arrears Clearance Month up to 30th September, 2005. The Board has agreed to the suggestion and I am desired to convey that all concerted efforts should be made to ensure disposal of pending Drawback claims **by 30th September, 2005**.

The Board is closely monitoring the pendency of Drawback claims in various Commissionerates. You may, therefore, kindly ensure that this items of work is attended to on top priority basis by the field officers under your charge. The result of the action taken in the matter may kindly be reported to the Board in the first week of October, 2005.”
