Payment & Cancellation

Full payment should be made along with **Application Form**, duly filled in latest by **14th July, 2011**. The payment should be made by way of **Demand Drafts** drawn in favour of “**EEPC India**” or **Swift Transfers** as indicated above.

Booking of space will be considered only after receiving 100% payment. 50% cancellation charges applicable if reservation is cancelled before **21st July, 2011**. Any cancellation after this date would result in 100% forfeiture. Acceptance of application and allocation of space will be at the sole discretion of the EEPC India.

Selection Criteria
