Project components : 1. **Component 1 (total funding source of US\$ 56 million)** : Investment in new water supplies for district towns where WSC are willing to contract out delivery of services through a competitive process (The “Competition Route”).

This component will be comprised of three sub-components :

- Sub-component A - Design, Construction and Operation of Water Supply Facilities;
- Sub-component B - Sanitation Fund, as a revolving fund in each participating province; and
- Sub-component C - Implementation Management.

This component will be prepared in two phases : Phase 1, for which preparation is already complete, comprises 15 towns in three provinces; and Phase 2 comprising up to 120 towns in 24 Provinces.

2. **Component 2 (total funding source US\$ 62 million)** : Investment to improve and expand services in well performing Water Supply Company (The “Performance Route”). The “Performance Route” is limited to well performing Water Supply Companies (WSCs) which meet pre-determined criteria based on their staffing ratio, unaccounted-for-water, and working ratio.

This component will be comprised of two components :

- Sub-component A - Design and Construction of Water Supply Facilities, and
- Sub-component B - Implementation Management.

This component will be prepared in two phases. In Phase 1, support will be provided to Haiphong WSC to rehabilitate the system in Kien An, a recently established urban district. Phase 2, will provide support to the WSCs of HCMC, Ha Tinh and Binh Thuan.

3. **Component 3 (total funding source US\$ 10 million)** : Non-subsidized water supply and sanitation lending facility. Under this component the Development Assistance Fund (DAF) would provide non-subsidized project lending for several water supply and sanitation infrastructure projects of technically and financially qualified public or private water supply companies.
4. **Component 4 (total funding source US\$ 1 million)** : Investment in capacity building for the WSS sector.
5. **Component 5 (total funding source US\$ 6 million)** : Management of Project Implementation. The key part of this component will be the international consultant to support the Central Project Unit (CPU) in project implementation, including preparation of Phase 2 of Component 1, support to all Project Preparation Units (PPMUs) on construction management, and overall project coordination.

The following procurement works and goods for Phase 1 is expected to be procured through International Competitive Bidding (ICB) :

- **Component 2** : Supply, install and rehabilitate water supply system for Kien An (Hai Phong).

There will be the following major consulting services required under Phase 1 :

- **Component 2** : Contract management & construction supervision
- **Component 4** : Capacity Building
- **Component 5** : Implementation consultant for CPU
- **Component 5** : Safeguards monitor
- **Component 5** : Financial auditor
