Why these countries?

- **Belarus** is the fourth highest importer of engineering goods in the CIS region, after Russia, Ukraine and Kazakhstan. **Venue of the BSM – Minsk.**
- Global engineering imports of the country and share of India is increasing at a healthy rate.
- **Russia** remains one of the most promising markets for Indian exporters. Before the global economic crisis, during which 2009 GDP declined 7.9%, Russia had a nine-year run of continuous rapid economic expansion, with GDP growing approximately 7% annually. It has emerged from the recession in the third quarter of 2009; and has posted a GDP growth of 3.8% in 2010. **Moscow, has been chosen as the venues of the BSMs.**
- **Ukraine** is believed to have the potential to become one of the economic bellwethers of the next century. It is the second largest importer of engineering goods in CIS, after Russia. **The BSM will be held in Kiev, the capital.**

China is the largest supplier of engineering goods to Bangladesh with 30% share and Japan is the second major supplier country with 7.3% share. Bangladesh's imports of engineering goods have grown at an average rate of 25-30% during the recent years.
