EEPC INDIA Invites Participation at Multi Product Trade Delegation to Ethiopia, Sudan & Egypt (13 - 21 February, 2011)

Ethiopia

Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia is the second-most populous nation in Africa, with over 85.2 million people and the tenth-largest by area, with its 1,100,000 km². The **economy of Ethiopia** is based on agriculture, which accounts for half of gross domestic product (GDP), 43% of exports, and 85% of total employment. This sector constitutes about 4 percent of the overall economy, although it has shown some growth and diversification in recent years. Much of it is concentrated in Addis Ababa.

Engineering exports in Ethiopia have gone up from USD 1153.46 million in the year 2008-09 to USD 1569.5 million in the year 2009-10 registering a growth of around 36%.

Sudan

Republic of Sudan is a country in northeastern Africa. It is the largest country in Africa and the Arab world and tenth largest in the world by area. It is bordered by Egypt to the north, the Red Sea to the northeast, Eritrea and Ethiopia to the east, Kenya and Uganda to the southeast, the Democratic Republic of the Congo and the Central African Republic to the southwest, Chad to the west and Libya to the northwest. The world's longest river, the Nile, divides the country between east and west sides. Sudan is the 17th fastest growing economy in the world with new economic policies and infrastructure investments. Since 1997, Sudan has been implementing the macroeconomic reforms recommended by the IMF. Rich mineral resources are available in Sudan including: petroleum, natural gas, gold, silver, chromite, asbestos, manganese, gypsum, mica, zinc, iron, lead, uranium, copper, kaolin, cobalt, granite, nickel, tin, aluminum.

Engineering exports to Sudan from India has been to the tune of ₹110493.75 million in the year 2009-10 (USD 2455.42 million). The major items of exports to Sudan have been Metal, Auto components, Transport equipments, Machinery and equipments, Primary and Semi-finished Iron & Steel.

Egypt

Arab Republic of Egypt is a country mainly in North Africa, with the Sinai Peninsula forming a land bridge in Southwest Asia. Egypt is thus a transcontinental country, and a major power in Africa, the Mediterranean region and the Islamic world. Egypt is famous for its ancient civilization and some of the world's most famous monuments, including the Giza pyramid complex and its Great Sphinx. Its ancient ruins, such as those of Memphis, Thebes, Karnak and the Valley of the Kings, are a significant focus of archaeological study, and artifacts from these sites are now displayed in major museums around the world.

Egypt possesses one of the most developed and diversified economies in the Middle East, with sectors such as tourism, agriculture, industry and service at almost equal production levels. The Egyptian economy is rapidly developing, due in part to legislation aimed at luring investments, coupled with both internal and political stability, along with recent trade and market liberalization.

The engineering exports from India to Egypt has been to the tune of USD 3990.72 million. The major items of exports have been Machinery & Instrument, Auto component and Transport equipment, Ferro Alloy and Machine tools & Iron & Steel.

Hotel Accommodation/Travel Expenses

Other individual expenses like hotel charges, food expenses, transport expenses for individual meetings/factory visits (if arranged by the Delegates) will have to be borne by the Delegates.

MDA Entitlement

Participants will be eligible to get reimbursement of to & fro air passage in economy excursion class up to ₹70,000 only as per MDA guidelines and also completely attending the BSMs in all the three countries.

Selection Criteria

In view of limitations on number of participants (15 only) selection of participants will be done strictly on first-cum-first served basis.
