**EEPC INDIA Invites Participation for India Pavilion at  
BIET 2011, Dhaka, Bangladesh  
(March 02 - 05, 2011)**

BIET (Bangladesh International Industrial Engineering Tradeshow and Symposium) is an annual show organized by Bangladesh Engineering Industry Owners' Association (BEIOA), which is an apex body of Engineering Industry and Entrepreneurs of Bangladesh. BIET 2011 has two concurrent shows namely KRISHI (Agricultural Machinery) & SOLAR EXPO (Solar Energy products). The last edition of the exhibition organized in year 2010 had 200 exhibitors and over 18,000 visitors. The trade show has on display latest technological advancements of industrial, engineering equipments, materials, services and technology in related fields from Bangladesh and foreign companies. The exhibition provides an ideal platform for joint ventures and transfer of technologies.

Engineering sector plays a crucial role in the growth of Bangladesh economy. International BIET symposium is based on the theme "*need for investments and joint ventures in the growth of Bangladesh engineering industry*". The exhibition provides an ideal platform to exhibitors and visitors in areas like joint ventures, transfer of technologies and appointing agents/distributors/ partners etc.

Trade data indicates that India's engineering exports to Bangladesh have grown consistently over the years and almost doubled between 2007 and 2008 from USD 225.57 million to USD 422.41 million in the year 2008. However during the recent year, India's exports to Bangladesh declined to USD 321.97 million, registering a decline of 23%. India has approximately 6% share as supplier to Bangladesh. China is the largest supplier of engineering goods to Bangladesh with 30% share and Japan is the second major supplier country with 7.3% share. Bangladesh's imports of engineering goods have grown at an average rate of 25-30% during the recent years.
