EEPC India is pleased to announce its next INDEE in Cairo, Egypt from 25th to 28th November 2010. The show will be a part of an event which brings together the most varied and complete exhibition of Machine Tools, Industrial Tools, Welding & Cutting Equipment and related services industries.

INDEE Cairo 2010 will coincide with MACTECH, AIRTECH, HANDLING EXPO and TRANSPOTECH. EEPC India invites you to be a part of this most representative industrial fair in the Middle East and Africa.

As the West Asia's largest annual manufacturing expo, MACTECH has for long been the connecting point between the manufacturing countries in Asia, Europe, America, the Far East and the importer countries in the Middle East and Africa. It brings together buyers, sellers and end users from around the world.

EEPC India had organized an Indian Engineering Exhibition, INDEE Cairo in 2006, as part of MACTECH 2006, held from 23-26 November, 2006 in which over one hundred Indian engineering companies had taken part. The event was a huge success in terms of business generated for the participants.

Why Egypt?

Egypt is the most populous country in the Arab world and has the second highest population of Africa. Egypt imports a wide variety of goods, especially capital goods such as machinery and equipment, necessary for its economic and infrastructure development. Today, the European Union, especially Germany, Italy, and France, supplies more than 40 per cent of Egypt's imports, while the United States accounts for 15-20 per cent of total imports.

Egypt has traditionally been one of India's most important trading partners in the African continent. The India-Egypt bilateral Trade Agreement has been in operation since March 1978 and is based on the MFN clause. India was the 4th largest trading partner of Egypt in 2007. Bilateral trade between India & Egypt amounts to US\$ 3.3 billion (2007-08). Indian investments in Egypt at present register US\$ 700 million and expected to reach US\$ 2 billion. While India's exports to Egypt have grown by 74.74% as compared to the previous year, the corresponding growth figure for engineering exports is 105.26%. Machinery, Instruments, Metals & Metal Products, Electrical Products, Automobiles & Components have been the major engineering products being exported at present to Egypt.

Cancellation of Participation

Request for cancellation of participation will be accepted if EEPC India receives the same in writing on or before **22nd October, 2010**. EEPC India shall not entertain any cancellation afterwards. Any cancellation after the due date shall result in forfeiture of the amount already paid on this account.

Selection Criteria

Selection of participants will be done **after receiving full payment strictly on first-come, first-served basis**.

Travel and Hotel Accommodation

EEPC India will assist participants in locating suitable airlines and hotels at Cairo, Egypt at negotiated rates through accredited Travel Agents. However, participants are free to make their own travel/hotel arrangements.

Visa

EEPC India will issue recommendation letters in favour of the representatives of the participating Indian companies in the exhibition for issuance of visa for the show. However, EEPC India will not give any guarantee to this effect, as this is the sole discretion of the Embassy of Egypt in India.

EEPC India will recommend for issuance of visas for a maximum number of two participants for each 9 sq. mtr. booth.



MDA Grant

All eligible participants will be entitled to MDA grant under Focus Africa Programme of the Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India as per the MDA Guidelines effective from April 01, 2006. The MDA guidelines can also be downloaded from <http://commerce.nic.in/mda-guidelines.pdf>

Assistance would be permissible on travel expenses by Air on return Economy Excursion Class fare and charges of built-up furnished stall subject to an upper ceiling of **Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand only)**.

Further, eligibility for MDA grant is subject to exporting companies having FOB value of exports not exceeding Rs. 15 crores in the preceding year, having completed 12 month membership with EEPC India with regular filing of returns and fulfilling other conditions, details of which can be obtained from respective Regional Offices of EEPC India.
