Mexico is the world's 11th largest automotive producer and is forecasted to rank 5th by 2011. The auto parts and suppliers industry in Mexico generates approximately 7.5% of the country's GDP. From August 2005 to January 2008, 17,76,284 vehicles between 11 and 15 years old and 10,73,654 vehicles 10 years old were imported into Mexico. In 2008-09, India exported nearly USD 93.73 million worth of transport equipment, including components, to Mexico. Transport equipment accounted for sizeable percentage of total exports from India to Mexico.

### **About the Event**
