

EEPC REGIONAL AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN EXPORTS
SCHEME FOR THE YEAR 2021-22

A. Categories, Types of Award & Numbers

The Award Scheme will have the following categories of awards and numbers:

B. Definitions:

(a) General definitions: The applicant should be a present member of EEPC India till the day of presentation of Award. For the purpose of awards, the applicant enterprises are classified in the following categories:

Micro Enterprises: Members falling under the category under the provisions of The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, Government of India and modification of the same came into effect from 01-07-2020

Small Enterprises: Members falling under the category under the provisions of The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, Government of India and modification of the same came into effect from 01-07-2020

Medium Enterprises: Members falling under the category under the provisions of The Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development Act, 2006, Government of India and modification of the same came into effect from 01-07-2020

Large Enterprises: All other manufacturer exporters

Merchant Exporters: Members having their registration as 'Merchant Exporter' in the RCMC of EEPC INDIA

Important Note: To substantiate classification as Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, the applicants are mandatorily required to submit one or more relevant pages of balance sheet with details of investment in plant and machinery as on 31st March 2022 duly certified by a Chartered Accountant. For this, the candidate has to submit investment in Plant and Machinery (Gross Block/Net Block) for the year 2021-22. No certificate regarding MSME/SSI/or Certificate from Directorate of Industries will be considered as valid without above pages of balance sheet and in that case the Award Application will be considered as incomplete and liable to be rejected.

In addition to the above document the applicants have to submit one CA certificate certifying export performance and the total turnover of the organization for the year 21-22.

Exporters registered as Merchant-cum-Manufacturers:

Merchant-cum-manufacturer exporters would be categorized according to their performances in the 'manufacturer' and 'merchant' category. Companies having exports predominantly in manufacturing category would be classified under the provisions of the MSMED Act 2006. Otherwise, they would be treated as a merchant exporter and relevant provisions would be applied.

(b) Definitions of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises:

(a) In the case of the enterprises engaged in the manufacture or production of goods pertaining to any industry specified in the First Schedule to the Industries (Development and Regulation) Act, 1951 and in the case of the enterprises rendering engineering services and the merchant exporters.

(i) Micro Enterprise:

The enterprise will be micro, if the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed one crore rupees and turnover does not exceed five crore rupees

(ii) Small Enterprise:

The enterprise will be small if the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed ten crore rupees and turnover does not exceed fifty crore rupees

(iii) Medium Enterprise:

The enterprise will be medium if the investment in plant and machinery or equipment does not exceed fifty crore rupees and turnover does not exceed two hundred and fifty crore rupees

(c) Definitions for the Top Exporter Awards : The General Definitions would apply to the Top Exporters Award with the following conditions.

For the applicant defined as a manufacturer exporter in large, medium, small and micro category, the overall export performance will be considered for evaluating the applicant for top exporter award however for a merchant exporter only merchant export performance will be taken into account for evaluation.

(d) Definitions for the Star Performer Awards: The General Definitions would apply to Star Performer Awards, with the following exceptions:

(i) The Star Performer awards would be distributed to three categories (a) Small Enterprises; (b) Medium Enterprises and (c) Large Enterprises.

(ii) Micro and Small Enterprises would be clubbed together under the head of Small Enterprises for the purpose of the Star Performer Awards. *However, the Micro Enterprises would get a double-weightage for the purpose over the Small Enterprises.*

(iii) For the purpose of Star Performer Awards, Merchant exporters having export turnover upto Rs 150 crore (total engineering export turnover across groups and not only for the specific Star Performer Group) would be categorized as Medium Enterprises. Merchant exporters with a higher turnover would be categorized as Large Enterprises.

(iv) For Star Performer Awards, after categorization, *exporters other than Merchant Exporters in the Large and Medium Enterprises categories would get double-weightage* in calculation of export performance over the Merchant Exporters.

(v) For awards under various 'Star Performer' groups, export turnover of the relevant products falling under the group, and not the entire export turnover, will only be considered.

(e) Definition of Special Trophy for Excellence in export of Engineering services: List of Engineering Services and code specified for those services is given in the Annexure II. For awards under different engineering and related services, export turnover falling under the groups of Engineering Services (not the entire export turnover) will be considered.

C. Eligibility Criteria

(i) For the Trophy for Top Exporters

The following threshold limits would be applicable for the Top Exporter Trophies

Rs 150 Crore for Large Enterprises

Rs 75 Crore for Medium Enterprises

Rs 5 Crore for Small Enterprises

Rs 1 Crore for Micro Enterprises

Rs 100 Crore for Merchant Exporters

An applicant should have some exports to his credit since 2019-20, i.e. the applicant should have some exports for all of the three years viz. 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

The applicant company should not appear in the 'Denied Entity List' of the O/o the DGFT at the time of finalization of the list of award winners.

In case applications matching the threshold limits are not received for any particular category, the Award Committee may adjust the threshold limits.

(ii) For all other awards

To compete in other categories of awards, the minimum export performance required is Rs 1 Crore. An applicant should have some exports to his credit since 2019-20, i.e. the applicant should have some exports for all of the three years viz., 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

However, Micro Enterprises do not have any minimum export performance requirement.

Merchant exporters can compete only in the Medium and Large Enterprises categories in the Star Performer awards.

The applicant should not appear in the 'Denied Entity List' of the O/o the DGFT at the time of finalization of the list of award winners.

E. Notes

Applicants of any of the EEPC INDIA Awards (All India & Regional) should be a present member till the day of presentation of the awards. If it is found that the member status of an award winner is cancelled (not present) on the day of Award Presentation, he will not be offered the same award.

The Award Committee of EEPC INDIA, was constituted from time to time by the Chairman of EEPC INDIA, would decide on the category of applicants and awards based on documentary evidences available with the award application.

The decisions taken by the Award Committee will be final and binding.

All applications would have to be mandatorily submitted online. However, the printed copy of the application form, along with the necessary documents have to be submitted within Fifteen (15) days of online submission to the Regional Director at the Regional office of EEPC INDIA. *In case the applicant finds any difficulty in submitting the data online, the Membership Department at relevant Regional Office can be contacted for an MS Excel format which can be subsequently filled and emailed to Membership Department of relevant Regional Office.*

For consideration of Award of EEPC INDIA, only direct exports *of engineering goods and services* of the applicant will be taken into account, as also indirect exports when the final exporter surrenders its claim in favour of the applicant.

Exporters of engineering goods (both merchant exporters and others), projects and services are required to fill in the respective portions of the application form, failing which the application would be liable to be rejected.

The total export turnover needs to be mentioned in the application form. The application form needs to be certified by a Chartered Accountant. Please note that the CA certificate must disclose Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) and Firm Registration Number (FRN) along with signature and seal of Chartered Accountant. Any such CA certificate without UDIN or FRN will be liable to be rejected.

For Star Performer Awards, if an applicant is found eligible to compete in more than one product panel, export turnover of only the relevant products would be taken into account.

Not More Than One Award will be offered to **any Award Applicants.**

(i) A firm qualified for “Top Exporter for the Year 2021-22” award will not get “Star Performers Award” for the Group **or any other Awards at All India Level for the same year.**

(ii) **Any exporter getting any Award at All India Level will not be considered for the same category of Award at Regional Level. Specifically the Top Exporter at all India level will not be considered eligible for any Award in the Regional level.** However, name of such exporters will be published in the respective Regional Award Brochures.

The exports which earn the foreign currencies in terms of USD or any other foreign currency unit will be considered as countable for the purpose of export award. Exports in Indian Rupees (INR) are not technically the earnings as, the country does not gain any valuable foreign exchange. For this supplies falling under the purview of Chapter 8 of the Foreign Trade Policy of the Government of India and termed as Deemed Exports will not be taken into account for the purpose of Export Awards of EEPC INDIA.

All applicants are required to clearly mention the award(s) applied for in the application form, failing which the applications would be liable to be rejected.

F. Documents to be submitted along with the application form

1. Application form duly filled up and certified by a Chartered Accountant. Please note that the CA certificate must disclose Unique Document Identification Number (UDIN) and Firm Registration Number (FRN) along with signature and seal of Chartered Accountant. Any such CA certificate without UDIN or FRN will be liable to be rejected. CA certificate will certify both export performance for the relevant year and total turnover of the organization for the same year.
2. IEC Certificate showing PAN;
3. Registration-cum-Membership Certificate of EEPC;
4. **Important Note: To substantiate classification as Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, the applicants are mandatorily required to submit one or more relevant pages of balance sheet with details of investment in plant and machinery as on 31st March 2022 duly certified by a Chartered Accountant. For this, the candidate has to submit investment in Plant and Machinery (Gross Block/Net Block) for the year 2021-22. No certificate regarding MSME/SSI/or Certificate from Directorate of Industries will be considered as valid without the above pages of balance sheet and in that case the Award Application will be considered as incomplete and liable to be rejected.**
5. A declaration in the letterhead of the Organization stating that the company is not in the 'Denied Entity List' at the time of submission of the award application.
6. A No-Objection Certificate in case the applicant had made some exports through other organization i.e. in case of Indirect Exports. Here the No-Objection certificate will certify that the final exporter has no objection if the applicant gets any award for his outstanding export performance.

N.B

- In the event, of any Award offered to any Exporter is found to be in appropriate, Award Committee will decide for corrective action. In the reverse case that is if the Award Application is found to be incorrect after the award is offered, Award Committee may request for withdrawal and return the same Award to its Regional offices as per their convenience.
- The Award Applications will be sent to the Regional Offices for selection of Award Winners at the Regional Level for the same year as considered for All India Level.
