

Germany's economy: A snapshot

Germany is the third largest economy in the world after USA and China and the largest economy of Europe. Its highly skilled labour force, continuous advancement in technology and well thought out development planning has made it one of the topmost destinations for trade and investments for the global players. Like the rest of the world, Germany also suffered economic losses during the pandemic, revival from which was mired by geo-political tensions across the globe. However, the country on its own have been progressing slowly towards a strong recovery.

According to forecasts of European Commission, growth is projected to rebound to 1.1% in 2026 as domestic demand strengthens, driven by continued consumption growth and a gradual recovery in investment. Prediction of leading research institutes says German economy is likely to overcome its three-year-long crisis in 2026 driven by growth-oriented infrastructure and defence package by the new government therein that led to a turnaround of corporate confidence and is expected to partly offset the impact of adverse and uncertain external environment.



India and Germany's Bilateral Trade

Germany is the fourth largest destination for India's engineering exports and the largest in European Union. Engineering exports to Germany was recorded at a USD 2.61 billion in 2021-22 which was lower than the previous two fiscals due to the pandemic, but the next five fiscal saw continuous rise in engineering shipment to Germany as it reached USD 4.23 billion in 2024-25 with a noticeable CAGR of 12.8%. Overall merchandise exports saw a sporadic trend but settled at an impressive USD 10.54 billion in 2024-25. Major engineering panels exported from Germany to India include electrical machinery, products of iron and steel, auto components/parts, industrial machinery for dairy, agriculture etc., medical and scientific instruments, auto tyres and tubes, injecting and moulding machinery, and IC engines among others.

India's Merchandise Vis-à-vis Engineering exports to Germany (USD Bn.)



The focus engineering product groups of this Hardware Fare broadly comprises of Industrial machinery. Exports of industrial machinery to Germany was recorded at USD 900 million in 2024-25.

Germany's Hardware industry: Prospects for India

Germany is the major hub of engineering sector in the Europe mainly due to its technological prowess, high skill level and geographical location. The manufacturing industry forms the backbone of Germany with the most prominent sectors being industrial machinery, automotive and chemical industry. Capital goods account for almost half of Germany's export followed by transport vehicles and their parts. Despite of a number of global adversities, Germany has shown improvement in ndustrial position on the global platform. Given this background, there is significant scope for Indian manufacturing hardware exporters in the German market and this event is therefore of great relevance for the Indian industry.

Benefit to the Member - Exporters

EEPC India is proposing to organise this event under the MAI Scheme of Ministry of Commerce & Industry, Government of India. On receipt of approval under MAI Scheme, the rates would be recomputed and the new rates are likely to be lesser in comparison with the normal rates offered by the Fair Authorities.

Cancellation of participation

Please note that no request for cancellation and/ or refund including of advances, if any and/ or adjustment thereof shall be accepted for any reason whatsoever. Once the application form and/ or advance/ part payments are accepted by EEPC India the participant remains liable to pay in entirety the amounts due from them on account of the event. In case members are not able to travel due to travel restrictions/advisory by Government of India or Germany then the amount paid will be adjusted toward the participation in the next edition.

Force Majeure

If a Force Majeure Event like war, act of God, natural calamities, governmental directives, civil commotion, epidemic, pandemic, etc. or alike events occurs inasmuch as that the fair authorities/ organizers consider that it is illegal, impossible, inadvisable or impracticable for the physical, onsite and in-person (i.e. 'live') elements of the Event to be staged, then in such situation and/ or circumstances the decision of the fair authorities shall be final and binding upon EEPC India and all its co-exhibitors/ participants. In such situation and/ or circumstances, if the fair authorities, organizers or the vendors appointed for providing diverse services related to the Event in question does not refund the monies paid by EEPC India and/ or does not otherwise absolve EEPC India from its contractual obligations then in such case the Co-exhibitors/ participants remain liable to pay to EEPC India the contracted participation charge in full and shall not receive any refund from EEPC India of the amounts paid by the co-exhibitors/ participants. Further, if the fair authorities, organizers or the vendors, so appointed for the Event binds or the co-exhibitor/ participant shall also be carried forward to such future editions of the Event and the amounts paid by them shall be given a credit for the successive edition. However, if there is any increment in the participation fees fixed by the fair authorities, organizers or in any other charges, budgets, etc. then such increased amount has to be paid by the co-exhibitor/ participant. In any event, a co-exhibitor / participant cannot decrease the space or the booth size booked by them for the originally scheduled Event.

Regarding goods taken out of India for exhibition or on consignment basis for export promotion, participants may refer to Circular No. 108/27/2019-GST dated 18.07.2019 of the Central Board of Indirect Taxes and Customs (CBIC) which is the statute in the matter.
