## Exports growth low in rupee terms

According to the provisional data available from DGCI&S up to October 2007, Exports during October, 2007 were valued at US \$ 13302.71 million which was 35.65% higher than the level of US \$ 9806.69 million during October, 2006. In rupee terms, exports touched Rs. 52560.85crore, which was 17.88% higher than the value of exports during October, 2006. Cumulative value of exports for the period April-October, 2007 was US\$ 85583.30 million (Rs. 347793.90 Crore) as against US\$ 70792.52 million (Rs. 324863.93 Crore) registering a growth of 20.89% in Dollar terms and 7.06% in Rupee terms during the same period last year.

#### Rupee appreciation prevents the progress of engineering exports

According to the provisional data available from DGCI&S up to June 2007, India's export of engineering goods have posted a strong growth of 20.54% during April-June 2007-08 in comparison to the same period in the previous fiscal. The provisional data indicate that exports of engineering goods from India have reached USD 7040.06 million up to June 2007. In the month of June 2007 Exports of Engineering goods were to the tune of USD 2558.56 million.

In rupee terms India's export of engineering goods are valued at Rs.29005.06 crores during April-June 2007-08 which is 9.12% higher than Rs.26580.55 during April-June 2006-2007.
