SUBCON 2019 saw an impressive 16% rise in visitor numbers for the UK's only event dedicated to subcontract and outsourced manufacturing services.

India UK Trade ties:

India and the United Kingdom share close and friendly ties. Bilateral relations between the two are based on common principles of democracy as well as common views on international trade. UK is among India's major trading partners and during the year 2018-19, UK ranked 16th in the list of India's top 25 trading partners. As per trade statistics of MoC&I, India's trade with UK in 2018-19 was US \$16.87 billion. India's main exports to the UK are articles of apparel & clothing accessories, power generating machinery & equipment, petroleum, petroleum products & related materials, miscellaneous manufactured articles, textile yarn, fabrics, made up articles, footwear, medicinal & pharmaceutical products, manufactures of metal, road vehicles and other transport equipment. The main imports from the UK to India are power generating machinery & equipment, non-ferrous metals, ferrous ores & metal scrap, general industrial machinery and equipment & machine, transport equipment, beverages, electrical machinery and appliances & electrical parts thereof, professional, scientific and controlling instruments and appliances, chemical materials & products. For the current fiscal 2019-20, India's export to UK stood at US\$ 6.4 billion during April-Dec 2019-20 compared to US\$ 6.91 billion in April-Dec 2018-19. On the other hand, India's imports from UK stood at US\$5.02 billion during April-Dec 2019-20 compared to US\$ 5.7 billion during April-Dec 2018-19.

Engineering is one of the major sectors of bilateral trade between India and United Kingdom - Both the countries are working to speed up negotiations on a free trade pact between India-UK to address the post-Brexit situation. India-UK engineering trade was registered at US\$ 6.6 billion in 2018-19 compared to US\$ 5.7 billion in 2017-18 with a growth of 15.6%, comprising a share percentage of almost 39% out of total trade.

Engineering exports for April-Dec 2019-20 is valued at US\$ 1.88 billion compared to US\$ 2.1 billion during same period last fiscal registering a negative growth of 10.5%. Engineering products such as electrical machinery, products of iron and steel, Aircrafts and spacecraft, auto components and parts, other industrial machinery, iron and steel, medical equipments, etc. are one of the main engineering segments exported to UK during April-Dec 2019-20 because of enormous demand in the region.
