### Exports growing steadily

Provisional figures available for November 2006 show that exports were valued at US \$ 9680.53 million (Rs.43417.85 Crore) during the month of November 2006 compared with US \$ 6163.92 million (Rs.28185.45 Crore) in November, 2005. Cumulative value of exports for the period April- November, 2006 was US \$ 79587.05 million (Rs. 364196.27 Crore) as against US \$ 57056.83 million (Rs.251173.34 Crore) during the same period last year. ### Engineering export recorded heavy growth

According to the provisional data available from DGCI&S up to October 2006, India's export of engineering goods have posted a strong growth of 37.75 % during April-October 2006-07 in comparison to the same period in the previous fiscal. The provisional data indicate that exports of engineering goods from India have reached USD 14450.07 million up to October 2006. In the month of October 2006 exports of engineering goods were to the tune of USD 2076.65 million which is 49.19 % higher than USD 1391.86 million during the same period last year.

In rupee terms India's export of engineering goods are valued at Rs.66311.66 Crore during April-October 2006-07 which is 44.29% higher than the value of export of Rs. 45955.96 Crore during April-October 2005-2006.
