Kolkata, Aug 24 (UNI) As one of the largest destinations for Indian exports, ASEAN will be an important region for India with an export target of US\$ 46 billion in meeting the global export target of US\$ 400 billion in financial year 2021-22, said Minister of State (MoS) of Commerce & Industry Anupriya Patel.

"ASEAN, with over 15 percent share in India's global engineering shipment, is likely to be a key region to focus with a target of around US\$ 16 billion of exports for 2021-22," the Minister said while addressing the India-ASEAN Engineering Partnership Summit organized by EEPC India. India's engineering exports to the world during the first four months (April-July) of fiscal 2021-22 was recorded at US\$ 35.5 billion and is strongly expected to achieve the target set for fiscal 2021-22 at US\$ 16 billion.

Ms Patel emphasized the need for opening up new avenues of bilateral cooperation in order to enhance engineering trade and investments between India and ASEAN. Eyeing \$46-b goods exports to ASEAN in FY22, says Minister

Engineering goods to make up \$16 b

India hopes to export goods worth \$46 billion to the ASEAN countries in 2021-22 to reach the target of \$400 billion set for merchandise exports for the fiscal, Minister of State for Commerce, Anupriya Patel, said.

Of this, engineering goods exports to the bloc are likely to be worth \$16 billion with both India and the ASEAN focussing on increasing ties in the area, the Minister said at the India-ASEAN Engineering Partnership Summit organised by EEPIC India.

India's goods exports to the 10-member ASEAN stood at \$31.5 billion (with overall goods exports from India at \$292 billion) and reaching the target of \$46 billion would call for an increase of around 50 per cent over last year.

"ASEAN, with over 15 per cent share in India's global engineering shipment, is likely to be a key region to focus with a target of around \$16 billion of exports for 2021-22," the Minister said.

Bilateral merchandise trade between India and the Philippines increased by over 21 percent between 2016 and 2018 to reach 2.36 billion US dollars but then declined to below 2 billion US dollars by 2020 due to economic slowdown in some of the emerging economies followed by the pandemic.

Philippines engineering trade with India also declined in 2020 due to the same reason before exhibiting a rising trend between 2017 and 2019.

India is the 13th largest exporter of engineering goods to the Philippines

India is the 13th largest exporter of engineering goods to the Philippines with around 2 percent share in the Philippines global engineering import. India's major engineering items exported to Philippines include Two and Three Wheelers, Iron and Steel and its products, Auto Components/Parts, Motor Vehicle/cars, Electric Machinery & Equipment and Industrial Machinery among others.

Estimated Indian investments in the Philippines are valued at more than 900 million US Dollars as on September 2019 spread across sectors like Textiles, IT&ITES, Infrastructure (airports), Chemicals, Automobiles and Pharmaceuticals. During the last few years, Indian companies have successfully executed some small and medium sized projects in the Philippines.

Philippines investment in India has been estimated at 335.40 million US dollars between April 2000 and December 2020. Areas of investments include Telecommunications, IT, Real estate and reprocessing of waste and Human resource development (management education).
